

### Semangat patriotik Taman Pulai Indah

SKUDAI - Semangat patriotik terserlah dalam kalangan masvarakat Taman Pulai Indah apabila program sambutan ambang merdeka anjuran lima kawasan rukun tetangga (KRT) di sini, baru-baru ini mendapat sambutan meriah penduduk dari pelbagai lapisan usia.

"Perarakan sejauh 5 kilometer itu menyemarakkan semangat patriotik kepada peserta dan penduduk yang berbaris di sepanjang laluan, melaungkan kata semangat sambil mengibarkan Jalur Gemilang.


"Aktiviti diselang seli dengan cabutan bertuah yang disampaikan
